PROBE Tour Coming to Bainbridge College Feb. 4

Bainbridge College will host representatives of 19 four-year colleges and universities in the Student Center on the main campus 9 a.m.-11 a.m. Feb. 4 for the annual PROBE Transfer College Tour. The event provides students information about transferring to those institutions in order to pursue bachelor's degrees.

Sponsored by the Georgia Education Articulation Committee, the tour goes to different two-year colleges, said BC Admissions Counselor Lindsey Overton, who is coordinating the local event. She said BC has hosted it before.

Although designed for Bainbridge College students, any interested person may attend.

College and university representatives from within Georgia are expected from Abraham Baldwin Agricultural College, Armstrong Atlantic State University, the Art Institute of Atlanta, Brewton-Parker College, Clayton State University, College of Coastal Georgia, Florida State University, Fort Valley State University, Georgia College and State University, Georgia Southwestern State University, Kennesaw State University, Mercer University College of Pharmacy and Health Sciences, Middle Georgia College, Thomas University, and Valdosta State University. Representatives are also expected from the Army National Guard, Walden University and other institutions from outside of Georgia.
