where they had the chance to meet Georgia Lottery President Rebecca Paul.

According to Executive Producer Todd Johnson, as part of the celebration, Austin Kelley Advertising of Atlanta developed four commercials depicting the positive aspects of the Georgia Lottery.

The Georgia Lottery for Education Act and the Georgia Constitution stipulate that proceeds from lottery sales are used to solely fund specific educational programs including Georgia's HOPE scholarship program.

Butler, a computer information systems major, found the experience educational and enjoyable.

"I learned that filming commercials requires a lot of repetition because the director wants to shoot things from different angles and using different ways. It also can require some waiting while the set crew gets the next scene ready."

"I had a blast doing this project and hope everyone enjoys watching it."
