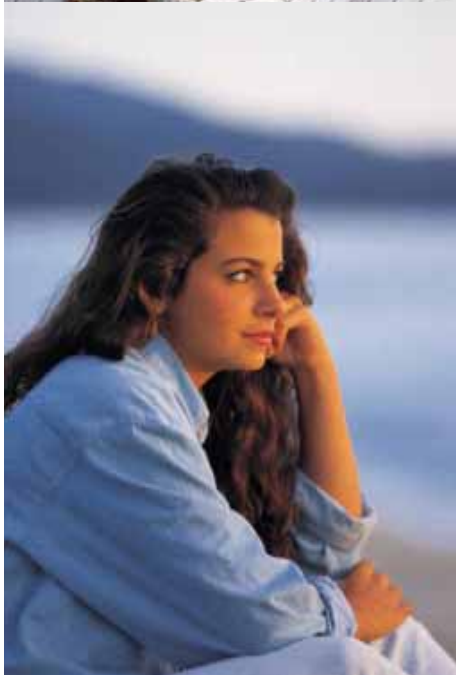
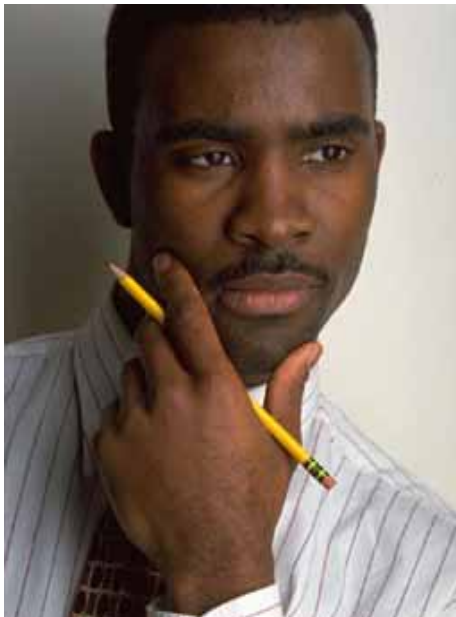

### ADMISSION PROCESS

1. Complete Application for Bainbridge College.
2. Successfully complete all degree level required developmental courses and necessary Core Courses. (See Admission Requirements at the College website: [http://www.bainbridge.edu/academics/tech\\_stud/ProgADN.htm](http://www.bainbridge.edu/academics/tech_stud/ProgADN.htm).)
3. If Human Anatomy & Physiology, and Microbiology courses are taken before program entry, the student must have taken the courses within five (5) years of ADN Program entry with a minimum grade of 2.0 for each course.
4. Take the HESI nursing entrance examination with satisfactory scores. Scores will be used as part of the competitive admissions process.
5. Complete Application for Nursing Department with Clear Criminal Background Check.
6. Complete all requirements within specified timeframe upon acceptance to program.

Admission to the ADN program is a highly competitive process with a limited number of spaces available. Students are chosen from applicants who have completed the application requirements by the deadline, based on a point system that includes grade point and preadmission testing scores.
