## In Brief

Bainbridge College ranked 38<sup>th</sup> among the fastest growing community, technical, tribal, junior colleges and two-year campuses of four-year colleges in the United States, according to Community College Week. The biweekly periodical also listed BC as the 26<sup>th</sup> fastest growing two-year institution among colleges with less than 2,500 students enrolled. The rankings place BC ahead of the two-year colleges in the University System of Georgia and fourth among Georgia technical colleges.



Bainbridge College will receive \$51,640.00 from the Georgia State Financing and Investment Commission to assist with improvements to campus facilities for compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and to provide better access for all students and faculty.
