In Brief

Bainbridge College's recycling efforts recently received national attention in a major survey. BC was listed in the top 8% as 1 of 22 leading schools nationally, and 1 of 2 leading schools in Georgia for recycling 60% or more of their total municipal waste generated, according to the first national survey of college and university environmental practices conducted by the National Wildlife Federation (NWF). BC now has wireless network access in all of the main buildings. This allows faculty and staff network access to the internet, e-mail, network apps (PLATO, Banner, etc.) from a laptop without having it tethered to a wall socket (on campus only!) This works in all campus buildings and in a small perimeter outside of each building.



BC's summer enrollment increased by 50% from 834 in Summer 2001 to 1251 in Summer 2002. BC Director of Admissions Connie Snyder attributes the rise to the economy, expanded outreach, new programs, and the recent tuition increase at Georgia's four-year schools.

River Regional Center a Reality



Funding for the new Bainbridge College River Regional Center (artist rendering) was approved by Governor Roy Barnes as part of the Board of Regents Capital Projects Budget. The 26,000 square foot facility will house a 250 seat auditorium, four classrooms, a 96 person capacity dining room, a 20 person capacity Foundation Board room, five offices, two AV studios, a catering kitchen, and a courtyard. A 95 space parking lot will also be developed at this time. "Three years ago, when the facilities master plan was being developed, we received total unanimity from faculty, staff, students, the community, and architects, to make a new auditorium the top priority," commented BC President Dr. Clifford Brock. "That dream is now closer to reality."
