Rules and Regulations

Registration

All Bainbridge College faculty, staff and students shall register their vehicle before operating and parking on campus. Vehicles can be registered and permits obtained at the Business Office between 8:00 AM and 5:00 PM Monday through Thursday and 8:00 AM and 12:00 PM Friday. The permit shall be affixed to the vehicle in the rear, driver's side window in a readily viewable manner. The person the parking decal is registered to is responsible for all violations by that vehicle.

All fines must be paid before the new academic year. No grades will be given until all fines are paid. Parking permits are the property of Bainbridge College and must be turned in should the owner terminate association with Bainbridge College.



Temporary Permits

Temporary permits can be obtained at the Business Office.

Regulations

All vehicle operators are responsible for find-

ing a legal parking space. Weather conditions or inconvenience is not an excuse for violating parking regulations.

No vehicle is to be driven or parked on Bainbridge College campus in any manner that will damage grounds, landscaping or facilities.

No vehicle will be parked at/on a yellow curb, fire lane, sidewalk, walkway, driveway, loading zone. Grass or seeded area.

No vehicle will be parked in a no parking zone, or area closed off by signs, barricades or not designated as a parking area.

No vehicle will be parked in such a manner as to obstruct traffic or parking in any area not designated as a parking area.

The speed limit on campus is 20 miles per hour.

All pedestrians have the right of way.

Report all vehicle accidents to campus security.

Towing

Any vehicle that appears to be abandoned or creates a fire/safety hazard will be towed at the owner's expense.

Any vehicle that has five or more traffic/parking violations will be towed at the owner's expense.

Fines

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Loss of Driving/Registration Privileges

Bainbridge College regards a person's use of a motor vehicle as a privilege that may be revoked for cause. Some specific reasons for which a person may lose their privilege of operating a motor vehicle on campus are:



- Driving under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs

- Failure to demonstrate a responsible behavior

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
