

Commercial Truck Driving Admission Steps

- ☞ Submit a BC Application of Admission form-list Commercial Truck Driving Special Certificate as your major.
- ☞ Submit a Certificate of Immunization form (available from the BC Admissions Office).
- ☞ Take the Compass Placement Exam or ASSET Test; minimum scores required.
- ☞ Submit a U.S. Dept. of Transportation medical card reflecting an approved DOT Physical and drug screen. [The Decatur County Health Department or other area physicians are available to complete DOT physicals and drug screens. Times vary so call the Health Department or physician of your choice soon to set up an exam. The Decatur County Health Department charges \$87 for a complete physical and drug screen. Minimum physical requirements include: 1) cannot take insulin; 2) blood pressure must be below 160/90; 3) eyesight must be at least 20/40 in each eye and both eyes (minimum with corrective lenses); and 4) you may be on blood pressure medication but you must take it.]
- ☞ Submit a Seven Year Motor Vehicle Report from the Dept. of Motor Vehicles (nearest location: Thomasville - Hwy 84 next to Thomas County Central High School)
- ☞ Complete the required forms to apply for the HOPE grant.

Additional Requirements

- ☞ Must be 18 years old to operate in the State of Georgia (21 to operate nationally).
- ☞ Must have an MVR report with no more than 8 points or 3 moving violations in last 3 years.
- ☞ No DUI in last 3 years, no more than one DUI in last 7 years.
- ☞ Must submit a DOT CDL card reflecting an approved physical and drug screen.
